1. Heard Mr. Achhari, learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. Instant revision is filed challenging the impugned order as at Annexure-2 series of learned JMFC (Rural), Berhampur, Ganjam in connection with G.R. Case No.760 of 2018, whereby, an application under Section 239 Cr.P.C. seeking discharge moved by him was rejected.
3. Mr. Achhari, learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioners happens to be the brother of the complainant, namely, opposite party No.2 and in so far as the complaint is concerned, it is on account of deletion of the name of the complainant from the RoR. It is also submitted that a suit in C.P. in 162 of 2017 is pending between the parties in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Berhampur, Ganjam concerning the dispute between them. In view of the facts pleaded on record and as discharge has been denied by



learned court below, the Court is inclined to issue notice to the complainant, namely, opposite party No.2 for a reply and response besides the State.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.
5. Notice to the opposite parties.
6. Mr. Ray, learned AGA for the State accepts notice for opposite party No.1. An extra copy of the petition with annexures is directed to be served on the State.
7. Notice to the complainant, namely, opposite party No.2 by Registered Post with AD making it returnable at an early date and for the said purpose, requisites shall be filed by Mr. Achari, learned counsel for the petitioner within seven days from today.
8. List on 17th July, 2025 for final hearing and orders.
