01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the CMP application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. By filing the present CMP application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the Defendant in C.S. No.428 of 2010 pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kendrapara has approached this Court for a direction to the learned trial Court to expedite the trial and to conclude the suit in a time bound manner.
4. On a careful consideration of the submission made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner and further taking into consideration the fact that the suit is of the year 2010 and in the meantime one and half decades have already elapsed, this Court is



inclined to direct the learned trial Court to expedite the suit and to make every endeavour to conclude the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of maximum one year. It is further directed that the Parties to the suit shall not pray for any unnecessary adjournments and cooperate with the learned trial Court for an early disposal of the suit.

5. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the CMP application stands disposed of.
