The matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.

2. This is an application filed by the Intervenor seeking intervention by way of an addition as an opposite party in the instant writ petition.

3. The subject-matter of challenge in the instant writ petition relates to the tender floated by opposite party no.2 for transportation of food grain/rice of PM Poshan (MDM) for district-Bhadrak. According to the petitioner, he has quoted the acceptable price, yet his offer has not been accepted by the authority.

4. The Intervenor contends that he has quoted the price which is reasonable and therefore, the authority cannot refuse to accept the same.

5. The core issue involved in the instant writ petition is whether the claim of the petitioner is sustainable on the basis of



pleadings so made and in the event the same is decided in affirmative manner, it would cause greater prejudice to the Intervenor and, therefore, renders the Intervenor as a proper and necessary party.

6. Accordingly, Interlocutory Application is hereby allowed. The Intervenor is directed to be impleaded as an opposite party in the instant writ petition.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to file the consolidated cause title of the writ petition reflecting the Intervenor as opposite party and serve a copy of the writ petition on the learned counsel appearing for the respective opposite parties by tomorrow (19.06.2025).

8. List this matter on 23rd June, 2025.
