01. 1. Mr. Gautam Mishra, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks leave of the Court to implead the informant as opposite party no.8 to the petition. Let him do so within two working days. Amended memo of parties be filed within two days.
2. Heard.
3. Issue notice to the opposite parties. Mr. Mohanty, learned State Counsel accepts the notice on behalf of opposite party-State and waives the notice.



4. Issue notice to opposite parties no.2 to 7 and the newly impleaded opposite party no.8 by Registered Post/Speed Post with A.D., fixing short returnable date. Requisites shall be filed within two working days.

5. Service of notice on newly impleaded opposite party no.8 shall also be effected through the IIC, Pattamundai.

6. List this matter on 23.04.2025.

7. In the meantime, the petitioner may move appropriate application before the learned trial court seeking adjournment in the matter owing to the fact that the present matter is pending subjudice before this Court. If such application is filed by the petitioner before the trial Court, the same shall be considered.
