1. Perused the office note.
2. The Deputy Registrar (Judicial) shall instruct the Dealing Assistants to mention the contents of the postal tracking report instead of asking the Court to look at the postal tracking reports.
3. Perusal of the order dated 09.04.2025 reveals that notice has been issued to opposite party nos.2 to 7 as well as the newly impleaded opposite party no.8 by registered post/speed post with AD. Opposite Parties Nos.2 to 7 are the proforma opposite parties.
4. Perusal of the postal tracking reports at Flag-B reveals that seven postal tracking reports along with the cause title of the CRLMC appear. In respect of one tracking report, it has been mentioned that 'item



returned addressee cannot be located’. But it is not apparent from which opposite party notice has been returned unserved as without mentioning the information in the postal tracking report, it has been stated in the office note that the reports be looked into.

5. Ms. S. Moharana, learned Additional Standing Counsel submits that notice on the newly added Opposite Party No.8 has been served through the IIC, Model P.S., Pattamundai, Kendrapara on 18.04.2025 and written endorsement to that effect has been obtained from Opposite Party No.8.

6. List this matter on 07.05.2025.

7. Interim order passed earlier shall continue till the next date.

8. Registry to verify if any counsel has appeared on behalf of Opposite Parties, especially Opposite Party No.8 and indicate the name(s) in the cause list.
