26.        1.        This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2.        On 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2025, Mr. S.R. Pattnaik, learned Additional  
Government Advocate had placed the opinion of the Second ALR-



cum-Additional Secretary to Government of Odisha, Law Department and suggested that the matter should be listed for final disposal, but on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2025, the learned State Counsel sought for an adjournment submitting that the brief has been misplaced. Today, Mr. Pattnaik, learned Additional Government Advocate also submits that the brief could not be traced out as yet. Hence, he prays for an adjournment.

3. Mr. Abhinash Acharya, learned counsel submits that Mr. Sailaza Nandan Das, learned counsel appearing for Opposite Parties No.3 and 4 is in bereavement and prays for an adjournment.

4. Since learned counsel for the parties are not cooperating for final disposal of the writ petition, this Court is constrained to adjourn the matter to 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2026.

5. It is made clear that no further prayer for adjournment shall be entertained on the next date.

6. It is expected that learned counsel for the parties shall co-operate with the Court to make an endeavor for final adjudication of the writ petition.

7. Interim order dated 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2017 passed in Misc. Case No. 14105 of 2017 shall continue till the next date.
