11. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This is an application for interim bail on the ground of ailment of the wife of the petitioner, who stated to be suffering from cardiac problem. Medical documents have been annexed to the interim application.

Learned counsel for the State was asked to obtain instruction and today, he has produced the written instruction dated 22.11.2023 of the Inspector in-charge of Bhadrak Rural police station, which indicates that the medical documents filed by the petitioner are genuine and on local enquiry, it was ascertained that there was no male person present in the house of the petitioner to take

care of the ailing person. The written instruction is taken on record.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties, the averments taken in the interim application, the documents annexed therein and the written instructions produced by the learned counsel for the State, I am inclined to release the petitioner on interim bail for a period of one month from the date of release and he shall surrender before the learned trial Court immediately on expiry of one month period.

Let the petitioner be released on interim bail for the aforesaid period in connection with Sessions Trial No.58/38 of 2015 from the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhadrak on furnishing bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand) with two local solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction with further terms and conditions as the learned Court may deem just and proper. During the period of interim bail, he shall not indulge in any criminal activities in any manner.

Violation of any terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of interim bail.

I.A. is accordingly disposed of.
