01. **1.** Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner.

He refers to the order passed by the Certificate Officer – cum – Sub- Collector, Bhubaneswar dated 13.03.2025 in Certificate Case No.105 of 2001. The said order is reproduced herein:

“Case Record is put up today. The Cdr is present and deposited the certificate dues of amount of Rs.30,37,46/- as mentioned in my order dt. 28.02.2025 and receipt the receipt from the Nazir of this office vide MR No.926933/224 dt.07.03.2025 of this office.

In view of the above facts, this certificate case is closed to the full satisfaction.

The Secretary, Odisha Khadi & Village Industries Board, Odisha, Bhubaneswar is requested to come/send a representative with authorization to receive the amount i.e. Rs.30.37.346/- (except cost and process fee of



Rs.20/-) on proper receipt/ acknowledgement from the Nazir of this office. Put up draft accordingly.”

2 It is submitted that even after satisfying the loan demand by deposit of the entire amount the Petitioner who was the loanee is not being issued No Objection Certificate purportedly on the ground that the amount has not been received by the Odisha Khadi and Village Industries Board. Learned counsel refers to the office letter dated 07.02.2026 issued by the Secretary, Odisha Khadi & Village Industries Board, Kharvela Nagar, Unit-III, Bhubaneswar which contains the following:

“Sub: Deposit of realised amount in Certificate Case No-105/2001 under OPDR Act. filed against the Cdr Smt Ratnaprva Mohapatra, Dist- Khorda- regarding.

Ref: Yours Letter No.265 dated 13.03.2025 and Memo No.233 dated 10.03.2025.

Sir

Inviting a reference to the letter and subject cited above, I am to intimate that one Smt Ratnaprava Mohapatra, Loanee was availed a loan under CBC Scheme and stated that she has already paid an amount of Rs.30.37,446/- in the office of Sub- Collector-cum- Certificate officer Bhubaneswar on dated 27.02.2025.

This office has been intimated the bank accounts details to remit same to OK & VI Board. But till date the same has not yet been deposited in Board account.

Therefore, once again the Bank account details of the Board is given below and request you to kindly deposit the realized amount in Board account.



Name of the payee: Secretary, Odisha Khadi and Village Industries Board Name of the Bank-State Bank of India, Govt. Treasury Branch, Bhubaneswar, Odisha, S.B Account No-11109338627, IFSC-SBIN0009025."

3. It is apparent from the perusal of the Annexure-5 and Annexure-3 referred above that the amount due has duly been deposited and the certificate has been closed.

4. Issue notice to the Opposite Party Nos.2,3 & 4, along with this order by Speed Post with Registration and Proof of Delivery indicating that the matter is likely to be disposed of at the stage of admission.

Requisites for issuance of notice to Opposite Party Nos.2,3 & 4 shall be filed within five working days.

5. Pendency of this petition shall not be of any impediment for the Opposite Party Nos.2, 4 & 6 to sort out the issue inasmuch as Opposite Party Nos.6 has already written stating that the amount due has already been deposited. Opposite Parties No.2 & 4 have also admitted that the amount has been deposited but the issue seems to be how the amount would be transferred from the account of Opposite Party Nos.6 & 7 to the account of Opposite Party Nos.2,3 & 4.

6. In any event the Petitioner can no way be held responsible for the intra/inter departmental



transactions between the Opposite Party Nos.6 & 7 on one hand and Opposite Party Nos.2 & 3 on the other.
