01. The complaint alleges non-compliance of the order dated 20.11.2025 entered in complainant's WP(C) No.30580 of 2025. Essentially, the direction was for consideration and such consideration having taken place, order bearing No.497 dated 06.04.2026 has been passed on the representation. Of course, no substantive relief has been granted to the Petitioner and reasons are assigned for this in the body of the compliance order. This Court exercising contempt jurisdiction cannot undertake critical examination of right or wrong of the order.

In the above circumstances, this complaint is dropped, reserving liberty to the complainant to assail the said order elsewhere in accordance with law. In that connection all contentions are kept open.
