- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.158 of 2026 pending on the file of learned J.M.F.C., Aul, arising out of Rajkanika P.S. Case No.80 of 2026 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 109/ 115(2)/ 117(2)/ 190/ 191(2)/ 191(3)/ 296/ 351(2) and 351(3) of BNS.
3. It is submitted by the learned counsel that since exaggerated allegations have been made against the Petitioners, they may be protected by pre-arrest bail.
4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for pre-arrest bail.



5. Taking into account the nature of allegations, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioners shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper.
6. Additionally, it is directed that the Petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional police station once every month on such date and time to be fixed by the learned Court in seisin once a month for the next three months or submission of the charge sheet, whichever is earlier. Certification of such appearance shall be submitted to the Court in seisin.
7. It is needless to state that the Petitioners shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.
8. The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
