 - 2.** The learned Senior Counsels appearing in the respective writ petitions submit that the copy of the counter affidavit filed by the CGST represented by Mr. Prasenjeet Mahapatra, learned Senior Standing Counsel has been received yesterday night and they did not



get an opportunity to peruse the same and prayed for a leave to file rejoinder to the said counter affidavit, if so warranted.

In course of the hearing, it is brought to the notice of this Court that a Special Leave Petition filed against the judgment rendered by the Andhra Pradesh High Court has been preferred and notice is issued in that matter. It is further informed that there is no interim order staying the operation of the said order is passed by the Supreme Court.

4. According to the learned Senior Counsels, mere issuance of notice in the Special Leave Petition does not overshadow the ratio of law decided in the said judgment and the matter can be conveniently decided after completion of the pleadings.
