01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned Additional Government Advocate for the State-Opposite Parties. Perused the writ petition as well as documents annexed thereto.
3. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayers:

“In view of the above facts and circumstances, the petitioner humbly prays that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus/certiorari or any other appropriate writ/writs by directing the Opp.Parties to re-engage/reinstate the petitioner in her service as Sikhya Sahayak or in any other equivalent post under O.P.No.7 or in any nearby Upper Primary School by quashing the order no. 127 dated.4.9.2019 under Annexure-7.

Or pass any order/orders as case may be deemed fit and proper in the interest of justice and



equity.”

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner may be granted liberty to file a fresh representation ventilating her grievance before the State of Odisha represented through its Commissioner cum Secretary, School and Mass Education Department, Khurdha, Bhubaneswar, Opposite Party No.1 which may be considered within a stipulated period of time in accordance with law.

5. Learned Additional Government Advocate on the other hand submits that he has no objection if liberty is granted to the Petitioner to file a fresh representation before the Opposite Party No.1 and the same is considered and disposed of in accordance with law.

6. In view of the aforesaid limited nature of grievance of the Petitioner, this Court disposes of the writ petition granting liberty to the Petitioner to file a fresh representation before the State of Odisha represented through its Commissioner cum Secretary, School and Mass Education Department, Khurdha, Bhubaneswar, Opposite Party No.1 ventilating her grievance within a period of two weeks. If such a representation is filed within the time stipulated, the same shall be considered and disposed of by the Opposite Party No.1 within a period of eight weeks from the date of filing representation by passing a speaking and reasoned order. The decision so taken on the same shall be communicated to the Petitioner within ten days thereafter.



7. With the aforesaid observation/direction, the writ petition is disposed of.

Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
