1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. In filing the present CRLA, the Appellant has challenged the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 30.03.2026 passed by the learned Ad-hoc Additional District and Sessions Judge (FTSC), Keonjhar in Special Case No.44 of 2017.
3. Heard.
4. Admit.
5. Issue notice.
6. Learned counsel for the State waives of notice on behalf of the sole Respondent. Let an extra copy of the appeal memo be served on him within three working days hence.

I.A. No.936 of 2026

12. The Appellant being in custody pursuant to the judgment of conviction and order of dated 30.03.2026 passed by the learned Ad-hoc Additional District and Sessions Judge (FTSC), Keonjhar in Special Case No.44 of 2017, has prayed for releasing him on bail.
13. Heard.
14. Learned counsel for the Appellant submits that the Appellant was all along on bail during course of trial and he has never misused the liberty granted to him. He, accordingly, prays for allowing the prayer made in this I.A.
15. Considering the submissions made on behalf of the Appellant and looking to the grounds taken in this I.A., this Court is of the view that the Appellant should be



enlarged on bail. This Court, accordingly, directs that the Appellant shall be released on bail in connection with the above noted case by the learned Court in *seisin* over the matter on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper with further condition that he will positively appear before the learned Court in *seisin* over the matter or before the authority concerned as and when required.
