1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
3. Since one of the offences is under Section 4(2)/6 of the POCSO Act, let an extra copy of the bail application along with all its annexures be served on the learned counsel for the State by 7th May, 2026, who shall send the same to the Inspector in-charge of Sabrang Police Station for its service on the informant in (Sabrang P.S. Case No.257 of 2023) and it will be intimated to the informant that the matter will be taken up on 20.05.2026 and if he/she so likes, he/she can engage a counsel to oppose the prayer for bail.
4. It will also be intimated to the informant regarding the availability of counsel from the High Court Legal Aid



Committee and if he/she agrees for free legal aid, signature/LTI be collected in the Vakalatnama by the IIC and sent to the Advocate General Office so that necessary steps shall be taken in that respect. A written proof regarding service of notice be obtained from the informant.

5. List this matter on 20th May, 2026.

6. Learned counsel for the State shall obtain 183 BNSS statement of the victim, her medical examination report, instruction regarding service of notice on the informant, case diary as well as instruction regarding criminal antecedents, if any, against the Petitioner in the meantime.

7. A free copy of the order be handed over to the learned counsel for the State for compliance.
