1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel appearing for the Opp. Parties.
3. Petitioner has filed the present writ petition inter alia with the following prayer:-

“The petitioner therefore most humbly prays that, this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to direct the Opp. Parties to regularise the services of the petitioner from 02.11.2013 i.e. on completion of six years of service as a Staff Nurse in terms of the govt. resolution dtd:17.09.2013 under Annexure-3 upon modifying her orders of regularization dtd:15.01.2021 dtd:22.01.2021 under Annexure-5 & 6 respectively and to grant all consequential service and financial benefits including seniority and promotion within a stipulated period as deem fit and proper; And/or pass any other order/orders/direction/directions in the fitness of the case. writ/writs,

And for this act of kindness as in duty bound the petitioner shall ever pray.”

4. However, taking into account the claim raised in the present Writ Petition, liberty is granted to the Petitioner to make a fresh



representation before Opp. Party No. 2 by enclosing all the relevant documents and citations in support of her claim, if any, within a period of three (3) weeks hence.

5. It is observed that if such representation is filed within the aforesaid time period, Opp. Party No. 2 shall do well to take a lawful decision on the same within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of such representation. The order so passed by Opp. Party No. 2 be communicated to the Petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
