Order No. 02

1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel appearing for the Opp. Parties.
3. Petitioner has filed the present writ petition inter alia with the following prayer:-

“The Hon'ble court may be pleased to

Admit the application;

Call for the records;

And

Issue a 'Rule Nisi' calling upon the opposite parties to show cause as to why a writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ/Writs shall not be issued.

And

If the opposite parties fail to show cause or insufficient cases the 'Rule' be made absolute.

And

Issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ commanding the opposite parties to pay immediately the pending arrear dues and DA's as were



given from time to time Since 2018 till date and to implement the 7th pay scale with effect from dt-01.04.2023 immediately, as the petitioner is going to be retired from service on 31.5.2026.

Issue any other writ/writs/order/orders as the Hon'ble Court thinks fit and proper.

And for this act of kindness the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray."

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that though highlighting his grievances, Petitioner has filed an appeal at Annexure-6 to the Writ Petition before the Opp. Party No. 2, but till date nothing has been done in the matter. In such background, learned counsel for the Petitioner prays that a direction be issued to Opposite Party No. 2 to take a decision on the above noted Petition within a specific time period.

5. Considering the submissions made and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court directs Opposite Party No. 2 to take a decision on the above noted petition in accordance with law, within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of this order and communicate the result of such exercise to the Petitioner.

6. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
