04.      1.      In spite of order dated 13.07.2026, the case diary has not been produced.
2.      Mr. Ashok Kumar Apat, learned Additional Government Advocate produces the letter dated 20.07.2026 of the I.I.C., Basta Police Station, where it is stated that the I.O. SI S. Kujur returned from Tamil Nadu on 14.07.2026 and was engaged in the follow up action of Basta P.S. Case No. 120 of 2026 after return from Tamil Nadu and also engaged in connection with Ratha Yatra duty, for which three to four days may be granted for furnishing the case diary before the Court.



3. The case diary is not the personal possession of the I.O. If he is engaged in any other important duty and considers that this case is not important, he can hand over the case diary to the I.I.C., Basta Police Station, so that the case diary / copy of the case diary can be sent to the Court. The personal presence of the I.O. is not required in the Court for production of the case diary.

4. List this case on 27.07.2026.

5. But if case diary is not produced by the next date, this Court may direct for personal appearance of the I.O. as well as the I.I.C., Basta Police Station.
