1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. The abovenoted I.A. has been filed at the instance of the Petitioner No.2 seeking modification of the condition No.4 (IV) of the order dated 06.05.2024.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioners, at the outset, contended that by virtue of order dated 06.05.2024, the Petitioners were allowed to go on bail subject to the terms and conditions as mentioned in Para-4 of the said order. One of the conditions was that the Petitioners shall appear before the concerned police station once in a fortnight for three months, thereafter they shall appear once in a month till conclusion of the



trial. Learned counsel for the Petitioners further submitted that since their release on bail in May, 2024, the Petitioners have been appearing before the local police station regularly. He further contended that there is no possibility of trial being started and concluded in near future. Therefore, such condition of appearance may be waived.

4. Learned counsel for the State on the other hand contended that she has no instruction in the matter.

5. Considering such submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioners, the condition No.4 with regard to their appearance before the concerned police station once in a month is hereby waived.

6. Accordingly, I.A. stands disposed of.
