1. Heard Mr. Pandey, learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. Instant writ petition is filed by the petitioners challenging the impugned order dated 9th October, 2024 passed in connection with First Appeal No.811 of 2024 of learned National Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission, New Delhi corresponding to Consumer Complaint Case No.22 of 2014 on the grounds stated therein and for a direction to pay 3% interest on the amount deducted at the time of premature encashment and dismissing the appeal on the ground of delay.
3. Mr. Pandey, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in view of the RBI Circular as at Annexure-2 and SBI Policy, a copy of the same as at Annexure-3, repayment charges are not leviable and hence, it was challenged by the Consumer complaint and it ultimately led to passing of the order as per Annexure-13. Considering the facts pleaded on record and above submission, the Court is inclined to consider the response of the opposite parties.



Mr. Mohapatra, learned counsel, who normally appears for the Bank and present in Court is requested to receive notice for the opposite parties and to take instructions. A copy of the writ petition with annexures is directed to be served on Mr. Mohapatra, learned counsel for the Bank for a reply and response on the next date.
