1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. The petitioner has filed IA No.1192 of 2025 U/S.5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 56 days in preferring the appeal.
3. Heard, Mr. Pramod Kumar Tripathy, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Pratap Kumar Behera, learned counsel for OPNo.1 and Mr. Ramesh Chandra Pradhan, learned counsel for OPNos.3 & 4 and perused the record. None appears for OPNo.2 despite valid service of notice.
