01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
3. This is an application for condonation of delay of 2332 days in filing the appeal.
4. Learned counsel for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for condonation of delay.
5. Taking into consideration the grounds taken in the petition for condonation of delay, this Court is inclined to condone the delay subject to payment of cost of Rs.2,500/- (Rupees two thousand five hundred) to be paid before the Juvenile Justice Fund managed by the Member



Secretary, Odisha State Legal Services Authority.

6. Accordingly, the I.A stands disposed of.
