01. 1. Heard Mr. Jena, learned counsel for the Petitioner, Mr. Saa, learned CGC for Opposite Party No.1 and Mr. Dash, learned AGA for the State.
2. The grievance of the Petitioner is that, the crude oil pipelines are being laid in the residential land of the Petitioner and in this regard a representation has been submitted to the authority.
3. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Collector, Balasore (O.P. No.2) to consider the grievance of Petitioner as per his representation under Annexure-4, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition. Till such decision is taken by Opposite Party No.2, status-quo as on date in respect of nature and character of the



land in M.S.Plot No.667 under Khata No.112 of Mouza-Nandika shall be maintained by both parties.
