01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement
(Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as
 learned Additional Government Advocate for the State-
 Opposite Parties. Perused the writ application as well as the
 prayer made therein.



3. By filing the present writ application the Petitioner calls into question the conduct of the Opposite Party-School in issuing a fresh advertisement for empanelment of Part-time Teacher at Annexure-4 to the writ application.

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that the Petitioner was initially appointed as a TGT in Computer Science. At the time of appointment in agreement was executed thereby appointing the Petitioner for a period which ends on 31.03.2026 or till appointment of a regular teacher. He further contended that such appointment was extended till 30.04.2026. In the meantime, the Opposite Parties have published an advertisement for recruitment of Part-time Teacher. While assailing the advertisement at Annexure-4, learned counsel for the Petitioner contended that the Petitioner was initially recruited subject to the condition that he shall continue up to a particular time or till appointment of a regular teacher in his place.

5. On the request of the learned counsel for the State, he is granted four weeks' time to obtain instruction in the meantime. Accordingly, issue notice to the Opposite Parties.

6. Learned Additional Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of Opposite Party Nos. 1 to 4. Since the soft copy of the writ petition has already been uploaded in the LMS, no hard copy is required to be served on the learned Additional Government Advocate.



7. Issue notice to the Opposite Party Nos. 5 and 6 by Speed Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.

9. List this matter in the week commencing 29.06.2026.

8. As an interim, let the selection process continue. However, no final empanelment pursuant to Annexure-4 shall be done without the leave of this Court. In the meantime, the Petitioner shall be allowed to discharge his duties till the next date.
