The matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.

Heard Mr. N.C. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner.

Against rejection of the grievance vide order dated 15.02.2021 under Annexure-10, in pursuance of the order dated 27.01.2021 passed in W.P.(C) No.2523 of 2021, the petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present writ petition.

Mr. N.C. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that so far as the provisional gradation list of 2nd phase work-charged employees is concerned, the employees named at sl.nos. 2 and 7 though were engaged as NMR, when they were underaged, but they have been placed senior to the petitioner, whereas the claim of the petitioner has been ignored. It is contended that though this fact was brought to the notice of the authority, the same was rejected vide Annexure-10 dated 15.02.2021.

Issue notice to the opposite parties.

Four extra copies of the writ petition be served on learned State Counsel appearing for opposite parties no.1 to 4 within three days enabling him to obtain instructions or file counter affidavit.

Steps for service of notice on opposite parties no.5 and 6 by registered post with A.D. be taken within three days. Office shall send notice to the said opposite parties fixing an early returnable date.

As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19

situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a print out of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned advocate, in the manner prescribed, vide Court's Notice No.4587 dated 25th March, 2020, as modified by Court's notice no. 4798 dated 15th April, 2021.
