01.        1.     This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2.     Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State-Opposite Parties. Perused the writ application as well as the prayer made therein.
3.     The Petitioner has filed the present writ application with the following prayer:

*“The Petitioner therefore prayed that your lordships may graciously be pleased to direct the Opp. Parties to sanction the family pension of the mother i.e. Late Lata Bai Tiwari, of the Petitioner, by considering the application dated 01.09.2025 under Annexure-12 and release all other consequential service and financial benefits without any further delay.  
And pass such order/directions as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper.”*



4. In course of hearing of the writ application, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner ventilating his grievance has submitted representation before the Principal, Laxmi Narayan College, Jharsuguda and Collector & Dist, Magistrate, Jharsuguda, Opposite Party Nos.3 & 4 respectively under Annexure-12. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that the said representation is pending as of now. It is also submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioner that a direction be issued to the Opposite Party Nos.3 & 4 to consider the representation of the Petitioner under Annexure-12 within a stipulated period of time.

5. Learned Additional Standing Counsel submits that he has no objection if the representation of the Petitioner is considered by the Opposite Party Nos.3 & 4, which is stated to be pending, in accordance with law within a stipulated period of time.

6. Considering the limited nature of grievance of the Petitioner, the writ application is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Opposite Party Nos.3 & 4 to consider the representation of the Petitioner dated 01.09.2025 under Annexure-12 within a period of eight weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order. The Opposite Party Nos.3 & 4 shall do well to dispose of the representation of the Petitioner under Annexure-12 by passing a speaking and reasoned order. The decision so taken by the Opposite Party Nos.3 & 4 be also communicated to the Petitioner within ten days thereafter.



7. With the aforesaid observations and directions, the writ application stands disposed of.
