1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is submitted that C.S. No. 207 of 2026 is pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1st Court, Cuttack. It is further submitted that C.S. No. 113 of 2017 and C.S. No.634 of 2013 are pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), LR & LTV, Bhubaneswar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the schedule of the properties mentioned in the suit to submit that the properties involved in all the three suits are same, although in the suit pending in Cuttack prayer is for partition and in one of the suits pending at Bhubaneswar declaratory relief is sought for.



2. Accordingly it is submitted that suits should be tried at one place and the suit in Bhubaneswar being the older one, the learned court at Bhubaneswar should try all the suits.

3. Issue notice along with this order.

Notice be issued to O.P. No.1 by speed post with registration and proof of delivery. Requisites for issuance of notice be filed within five working days.

Returnable date be fixed to 25.06.2026. The matter shall be listed in the week commencing 6.7.2026.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for petitioner that proforma opposite parties 2 to 32 may not be issued notice for the time-being, awaiting appearance of O.P. No.1.

5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner. He reiterates his submissions as noted above.

6. Issue notice as above.

Accept one set of process fee as well as postal requisites as directed above.

Returnable date as well as next date of listing shall be as indicated above.

7. In the interim it is directed that upon a prayer being made before learned court in seisin of the matter, C.S. No. 207 of 2026 and I.A. No. 1 of 2026 arising out of the said C.S. shall be adjourned to a date beyond 10.07.2026 as would be convenient to the learned court in seisin of the matter.



8. In view of the above interim order passed in the present petition, in the fitness of things, the C.S. No. 113 of 2017 and C.S. No. 634 of 2013 pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), LR & LTV shall be adjourned beyond 10.07.2026 to a date as would be convenient to the court(s) upon a prayer being made for the said purpose.
