01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners. Perused the CMP application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. By filing the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the Plaintiff in C.S. No.1926 of 2025, pending in the court of learned 1st Addl. Civil Judge, (Sr. Division), Bhubaneswar, has approached this Court challenging the order dated 04.04.2026 at Annexure-6 to the application.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, at the outset, contended that after filing of the WS, the plaintiff filed an application under Order 1 Rule 10 of the CPC seeking to implead one Khetra Mohan Rana, who has been named in the WS, on the ground that the Defendant has entered into an agreement for sale with him. The said application for impleadment was rejected by the learned trial court on the ground



that no sale transaction has been concluded as yet. Being aggrieved by the said order, the plaintiff has approached this Court by filing the present CMP application.

5. On a prima facie examination of the impugned order, this Court is of the view that the matter requires further consideration in presence of the Opposite Party.

6. Hence, issue notice to the Opposite Party by Speed Post with A.D. by fixing a short returnable date. Requisites be filed within three working days.

7. List this matter in the week commencing 29th June, 2026.

8. As an interim it is directed that on an application being filed by the Petitioner seeking adjournment, the learned trial court shall do well to adjourn the matter for a period of eight weeks.
