Heard Mr. S.C. Satapathy, learned counsel for the petitioners.

The petitioners have filed this writ petition challenging the order dated 06.04.2018 passed by the learned Member (Judicial), Central Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack Bench, Cuttack in O.A. No.260/00184 of 2014 wherein the Tribunal quashed the order of rejection dated 18.10.2012 and directed the petitioners to provide employment assistance to opposite party no.1 on compassionate ground within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of the order.

Mr. S.C. Satapathy, learned counsel for the petitioners states that learned Tribunal has not considered the circular issued by the authority in proper perspective and also has not examined the order passed by the Patna Bench Tribunal in O.A. No.051/00/104 of 2016. Therefore, the petitioners seek interference of this Court.

In our view, the matter requires consideration.

Issue notice to the opposite parties in the main case as well as interim application by Registered Post with A.D. fixing a short returnable date. Requisites shall be filed within three days. Accept one set of process fee.
