1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the CMP application as well as the prayer made therein.
 3. By filing the present CMP application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the plaintiff in C.S. No.82 of 2019, pending before the Court of learned Civil Judge, Senior Division, Keonjhar, has approached this Court challenging the order dated 20.03.2026 passed in the abovenoted suit by the learned Civil Judge, Senior Division, Keonjhar.
 4. Upon hearing the learned counsel for the Petitioner, on a careful examination of the impugned order dated 20.03.2026, this Court is of the view that the matter requires further examination in presence of the Opposite Parties.



5. Hence, issue notice to the Opposite Party No.1, who is defendant No.5 in the abovenoted suit and who was subsequently impleaded as a party therein, and on whose application the impugned order in the present case has been passed. Requisites for issuance notice be filed within three working days.

6. Notice to Opposite Party Nos.2 to 4 are dispensed with for the time being.
