This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the opposite parties.

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners challenging the order dated 06.02.2025 passed in O.A. No.335/2024 and order dated 26.03.2025 passed by the learned Central Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack Bench, Cuttack in R.A. No.0006/2025.



Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the original application vide O.A. No.260/00335/2024, was filed by the opposite party no.1. An interim order was passed on 06.02.2025 and the petitioners filed the review application i.e. on R.A. No.260/006 of 2025 on 01.03.2025, which would be evident from Annexure-11. But the learned Tribunal has erroneously taken 24.03.2025 as the date of filing of the review application, therefore, it suffered delay, as it was beyond the time stipulated under Rule-17 of the Central Administrative Tribunal Procedure Rules, 1987, which stipulates that the review application shall be entertained only if it is filed within 30 days from the date of receipt of the copy of the orders impugned in the review petition. Learned counsel submits that the error is apparent on face of the record.

Issue notice on the question of admission indicating therein that the matter shall be disposed of at the stage of admission.

Mr. Rajesh Kumar Mahapatra, learned Senior Panel Counsel (Union of India) appears on behalf of the opposite party no.2 by filing the memo of appearance in the Court today, which is taken on record.

So far as the opposite party no.1 is concerned,
