This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Learned counsel for the State has produced the written instruction received from the Deputy Superintendent of Police, In-charge, Barkote police station dated 04.09.2025, which indicates that the appellant no. 2 Pari @ Parikhit Sahu @ Rabinarayan Pradhan is dead. The written instruction is taken on record.

Since none of the near relative of appellant no.2 Pari @ Parikhit Sahu @ Rabinarayan Pradhan has filed any application seeking leave to continue the appeal within the prescribed period and as per the proviso mentioned under sub-rule (2) of section 394 of Cr.P.C. corresponding to section 435 of B.N.S.S., the appeal



shall finally abate on the death of the appellant no.2 Pari @ Parikhit Sahu @ Rabinarayan Pradhan is concerned.

The report further indicates that appellant no.1 Ranjan Sahu and appellant no.3 Khetrabasi Behera are alive.

In view of the said report, this CRLA survives so far as appellant no.1 Ranjan Sahu and appellant no.3 Khetrabasi Behera are concerned.
