12. We have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused criminal antecedents of the present appellant. First of all we note that the affidavit which was filed in support of interim bail prayer does not contain correct averment, so far as relationship of the appellant with the deceased and the deponent is concerned.

Be that as it may, taking a compassionate view, we direct the present appellant Sk. Rahul @ Rahul @ Sk. Saheed to be taken out on parole/interim bail from jail on 19th September, 2016 in police custody to participate in the 20th day death ceremony of his father. Appellant shall be brought out from jail in police custody. He is permitted to participate in the 20th day death ceremony of his late father and then after the ceremony is over, he is directed to be relodged in jail. The matter is directed to be come up on Board again on 22nd September, 2016 when an affidavit shall be filed by the State regarding compliance of the order.

The Misc. Case is disposed of.
