1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Government Advocate for the State.
3. The petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayer:

*“The petitioner therefore prays that this Hon’ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit this petition issue notice to the Opp.Party by considering the facts and ground stated above, a direction may issue to the Opp.Party for issuance of Final ROR (Patta) in favour of the petitioner as per the order passed on 25.11.2024 in RRP No. 210/2021 by the Additional Sub-Collector, Puri-cum- Consolidation Officer, Nimapara.
