01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. This I.A. has been filed on behalf of the appellant in RSA No.253 of 2025 praying for exempting him from payment of Court Fees, as the appellant belongs to Scheduled Tribe community having his sub-caste as Bhumija.
3. In pursuance to the proof of the caste of the appellant as Bhumija, the appellant has filed the Caste Certificate issued by the Revenue Officer on dated 15.04.2025, from which it is evident that, the appellant in the second appeal vide RSA No.253 of 2025 belongs to Scheduled Tribe community.
4. So, in view of the provisions of law envisaged in Section 35 of the Court Fees Act, 1860 and the notification of the Government of Odisha, he (the petitioner in this I.A. and appellant in the second appeal vide RSA No.253 of 2025) is exempted from paying the Court Fees.



4. As such, the I.A. filed by the petitioner is allowed and disposed of finally.
