01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State-Opposite Parties. Perused the writ application as well as the prayer made therein.
3. Being aggrieved by the letter dated 08.04.2026 at Annexure-6 of the office of the Collector, Kandhamal, Phulbani-Opposite Party No.2, the Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present writ application.
4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, at this juncture, contended that although the Petitioner's caste certificate is pending for verification before the State Level Scrutiny Committee and he is awaiting issuance of a QR based certificate, however, in the meantime, the Petitioner has been directed to furnish such



certificate on or before 29.04.2026. He further submitted that issuance of such certificate is not under control of the Petitioner. As such, learned counsel for the Petitioner contended that the Petitioner is likely to be seriously prejudiced if the case of the Petitioner is not considered for promotion from Sevika to TGT.

5. Considering the request made by learned counsel for the State, he is granted four weeks' time to obtain instruction in the matter.

6. List this matter in the week commencing 29.06.2026.

8. As an interim measure, it is directed that one post of TGT SC (W) shall not be filled by the Opposite Party No.3 till the next date.
