- 1.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

It is therefore prayed that the Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit the case and call for the records and after hearing both the parties pass the following reliefs:

(i) To direct the Opp. Parties to regularize the service period from 06.01.2007 to 27.07.2009 and release the salary for the said period of petitioner with 12% interest.

(ii) To pass such other order/orders as would be deemed fit and proper.

And for this act of kindness, the Petitioner as I duty bound shall ever pray.

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting his grievances, Petitioner has made a representation available at Annexure-11 to the Writ Petition



before Opposite Party No.2 and the same may be directed to be considered and disposed of within a stipulated time period to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.

5. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties and after going through the records, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, dispose of the Writ Petition with a direction on Opposite Party No.2 to consider and dispose of the representation vide Annexure-11 in accordance with law, within a period of three (3) months from the date of receipt of this order with due communication to the Petitioner.

6. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
