1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Learned counsel for the State on instruction furnished the criminal antecedent of the appellant from the case diary.
3. On perusal of the criminal antecedent of the appellant it appears that he is involved in total 9 numbers of cases out of which this Court observes that in 3 cases allegations have been made for commission of offence punishable under Section 420 of I.P.C. and other allied offences.
4. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the appellant on the other hand contended that the total amount alleged in the present case against the present appellant is about Rs.2,00,000/- whereas



learned counsel for the State disputed the same and submitted the actual amount is more than that which has been stated by the learned Senior Counsel for the appellant.

5. In such view of the matter, learned counsel for the State is directed to obtain specific instruction from the I.O. with regard to the amount involved in the above noted 3 cases where the offence is punishable under Section 420 and other allied offences of the I.P.C. and accordingly, intimate this Court by the next date. Further, the instruction, so obtained from the I.O., shall be filed by Friday. After serving a copy thereof on learned Senior Counsel appearing for the appellant.

6. List this matter on next Monday (23.12.2024).

7. Learned Senior Counsel for the appellant on the other hand contended that although one bank account of the present appellant kept in Axis Bank, Satyanagar Branch, BBSR bearing Account No.024010100115537, has not been attached, however, the appellant has not been permitted to operate the said account. In such view of the matter, learned counsel for the State shall obtain specific instruction and appraise this Court by the next date.
