Considering the submission of Shri S.K. Mishra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellants and going through the judgment impugned herein, this Court observes, the appeal needs to be admitted on the following substantial question of law:

“(i) Whether the conclusion of the learned Appellate Court that the appellants have not shown sufficient cause for the delay in filing the appeal is perverse and contrary to the settle position of law?

(ii) Whether the compromise decree passed in C.S. No.156 of 1994 confers any title on the respondents and whether the same has any binding effect on the appellants particularly when they were not parties to the said suit?”
