01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State. Perused the Anticipatory Bail Application as well as the F.I.R.
3. This is an application under Section 482 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 filed by the Petitioners for anticipatory bail, involving offence punishable under Sections 115(2)/ 126(2)/296/304/74/3(5) of BNS, 2023 in G.R. Case No.187 of 2026 in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Rajanagar arising out of Talchua P.S. Case No.62 of 2026.
4. On perusal of the record it appears that all the offences are bailable in nature. In such view of the matter, this Court is of the



considered view that the present anticipatory bail application is not maintainable.

5. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application is disposed of by granting liberty to the Petitioners to approach this Court again for pre-arrest bail in the event any higher offences are added directing filing of the charge-sheet.

6. The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
