1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).

2. Mr. Pradeep Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for RNos.1 to 4 submits that R-5-Sibaram Behera is already dead and his legal heirs are on record. In support of such contention, he filed a memo along with the copy of death certificate, which are taken on record. Accordingly, the name of R-5 stands deleted from the appeal memo.

3. Since the appellant has already filed the cheque of Rs.25,000/- towards the statutory deposit, the cheque amount be invested in the name of Registrar (Judicial) in any Nationalized Bank by opening an interest bearing account renewable from time to time. Accordingly, the IA No.1474 of 2025 stands disposed of.



4. It is apprised by learned counsel for the appellant that the appellant-petitioner has already paid the deficit Court fees. Accordingly, the IA No.1194 of 2025 stands disposed of.

5. The appellant-petitioner has filed IA No.1386 of 2025 U/S.5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 135 days in preferring the appeal.

6. Heard. Since Mr. Pradeep Kumar Mishra, learned counsel has already appeared for Respondent-OPNos.1 to 4 by waiving notice, issue notice on hearing on admission and question of limitation to the Respondent-OPNo.6 by Speed Post with AD fixing a short returnable date. Requisites for issuance of notice shall be filed within three working days.
