19. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This is an application for interim bail on the ground of ailment of mother of appellant- petitioner no.4 Manoj Kumar Sahu.

Learned counsel for the State was asked to obtain instruction on this application.

Today, learned counsel for the State has produced the letter of Inspector in-charge of

Purusottampur police Station dated 09.11.2021 in which it is mentioned that the mother of appellant – petitioner no.4 was undergoing treatment at M.K.C.G. Medical College and Hospital, Burla on 31.01.2021 and 06.02.2021 and recent copies of the medical treatment were not submitted by the mother of appellant no.4.

This interim application was filed on 20.09.2020 and the learned counsel for the appellant petitioner no.4 has not produced any document to show that after 06.02.2021 the mother of the petitioner no.4 has undergone any treatment in any hospital. Therefore, I am not inclined to release the appellant- petitioner no.4 on interim bail.

The prayer for interim bail of appellant petitioner no.4 stands rejected.

The I.A. is accordingly dismissed.
