1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties.
4. This application has been filed by the Appellant No. 1 seeking grant of interim bail inter alia on the ground that Appellant No. 1 has to attend the obsequies ceremony of his deceased mother who died on 17.11.2025.
5. It is contended that Appellant No. 1 is the only son of his deceased mother and his presence is very much required for the aforesaid ceremony.
- 5.1. In support of the death of the mother of Appellant No. 2, reliance was placed to the letter issued by the concerned Gram Panchayat on 17.11.2025 vide Annexure-A.
- 5.2. It is also contended that Appellant No. 1 on earlier occasion was released on interim bail by this Court, but he has not violated the terms and condition of the said order.
6. Learned Addl. Govt. Advocate on the other hand contended that if this Court is inclined to grant interim bail considering the



grounds taken in the interim application, stringent condition be imposed.

7. Having heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties, considering the submission made and the fact that mother of Appellant No. 1 has died on 17.11.2025, this Court is inclined to direct for release of Appellant No. 1 on interim bail for period of one (1) month to be counted from the date of release of such terms and condition as deem fit and proper by the learned counsel in seisin. However, it is observed that Appellant NO. 1 shall surrender immediately after completion of the interim bail period without fail.

8. I.A. accordingly stands disposed of.
