- 34.** 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical) Mode.
2. Heard Mr. B. Panigrahi, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Appellant NO.3-Krushna Behera and learned counsel appearing for the State.
3. This application has been filed seeking grant of interim bail for a period of 21 days for enabling the Appellant No.3-Krushna Behera to attend the obsequie ceremony, as his father has died as per the report provided by the concerned Sarapanch of the Grama Panchayat on 27.11.2025 under Annexure-7 to the I.A.
4. It is also contended that Appellant NO.3-Krushna Behera though has been allowed interim bail on different occasion, but he has not misutilised the liberty at any point



of time. It is accordingly contended that Appellant No.3 be granted Interim bail for a period of 21 days.

5. Learned Addl. Govt. Advocate also fairly contended that Appellant No.3-Krushna Behera has not mis-utilized the liberty granted by this Court at any point of time.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, considering the submission made and the fact that father of Appellant No.3 had died on 27.11.2025, this Court is inclined to allow the Interim Application. Let the appellant No.3-Krushna Behera be released on bail for a period of 21 days to be counted from the date of his release, on any terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by the Court in session. Appellant No.3 is directed to surrender immediately after completion of the interim bail.

7. The I.A stands disposed of.
