This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.

2. Perused the minutes at Flag-1, wherein the Hon'ble Chief Justice has been pleased to assign this matter to this Bench for analogous hearing along with other matters connected.

3. Today when the matter is taken up, Mr. Susanta Kumar Dash, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that W.P.(C) No.6844 of 2018 is tagged to this case along with others. A Division Bench of this Court heard the matter. In the said case, challenge was made against the order dated 26.10.2017 passed in O.A. No.1530(C) of 2014 by the Odisha Administrative Tribunal. However, there being divergent views expressed by the Bench, the matters in W.P.(C) Nos.6844 of 2018, 19023 of 2019 and 13517 of 2019 were directed to be placed before the Hon'ble Single Bench



(3rd Judge). Mr. Dash, learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that since the third Judge who assigned with the matter is retired, these matters may require fresh assignment.

4. Mr. Manoja Kumar Khuntia, learned counsel for the petitioner further pointed out that in W.P.(C) No.6845 of 2018 challenge has been made to order of the Odisha Administrative Tribunal, the same is required to be heard by a Division Bench. Accordingly, W.P.(C) No.6845 of 2018 be de-linked from the present Batch.

5. Registry is instructed to segregate the relevant writ petitions and obtain fresh approval of the Hon'ble Chief Justice.
