1. This CRLMP has been filed for a direction to the Opposite Party No.3 to register the FIR based on complaint dated 04.04.2025 (Annexure-1) and also direct to the Opposite Party No.2 to supervise the investigation.
 2. Pursuant to order dated 22.06.2026, Mr. Sarathi Jyoti Mohanty, learned Additional Standing Counsel produces the instructions dated 04.07.2026 of the I.I.C., Aska Police Station who has stated that after receiving the letter from office of the learned Advocate General, he had contacted the Petitioner (no details of the letter, has been indicated in the instructions), he tried to contact the Petitioner over his mobile number many



times, but the number was always switched off. He has also stated that after he is able to establish contact with the Petitioner, the case will be registered at the Aska Police Station.

3. In view of this development, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that she will intimate the Petitioner, to contact the I.I.C., Aska Police Station and if required go to the Police Station for the purpose of registration of FIR. Mr. Mohanty, learned Additional Standing Counsel shall provide the mobile number of the I.I.C., Aska Police Station to Ms. Kalpana Nayak, learned counsel for the Petitioner for intimating to the Petitioner.
