01. 1. The marriage between the petitioner no.1 and the opposite party no.2 had taken place in the year 2009. Due to the lack of compatibility, misunderstanding took place between the parties. Therefore, the petitioners filed a divorce petition vide Civil Proceeding (Matrimonial) No.32 of 2023 in the Court of the learned Judge, Family Court, Jharsuguda on 21.03.2024. Subsequent thereto, the opposite party no.2 initiated a criminal prosecution by filing 1.C.C. Case No.4 of 2023, *inter alia*, making various



allegations against the husband or in-laws.

2. Issue notice to the opposite party no.2 by Registered Post with A.D. returnable within three weeks. Requisites shall be filed within a week.

3. Since the dispute is arising out of a matrimonial dispute, I am of the considered view that the parties should explore the possibility of settlement through mediation. The parties are relegated to the District Legal Services Authority, Jharsuguda. The Coordinator, DLSA, Jharsuguda shall fix a date and intimating the parties concerned for participating in the mediation process.

4. Awaiting the mediation report, list this matter on 22.08.2024.

5. In the meantime, the further proceeding in 1.C.C. No.4 of 2023 pending in the Court of the learned J.M.F.C., Rajgangpur is stayed till the next date.
