- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the State. None appears from the side of the Petitioner.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks the following relief:

*“It is, therefore, most humbly and respectfully prayed that this Hon’ble Court may be graciously pleased to issue Rule Nisi calling upon the Opp. Parties to show cause as to why :-*

*1. The letter No-1043, dtd. 20.04.2021 under Annexure-8 shall not be modified with regard to Petitioner’s selection for preparation and distribution of THR material for Jaleswar ICDS Project for financial year 2021-22 instead of one month ;*

*2. The Petitioners shall not be allowed to continue to prepare and supply of THR (Chhatua/Ladoo) in respect of - Jaleswar ICDS Project in the district of Balasore for the entire year i.e., up to 31st March 2022 as per the revised guideline, 2018 as well as subsequent clarification dtd.25.07.2019 issued by Govt. ; .*

*If the Opp. Parties fail to show cause or show insufficient cause, the Rule may be made absolute; And pass any other order/orders as would be deemed fit and proper;”*



3. As regards the nature of relief, which relates to the Financial Year 2021–22 concerning the preparation and distribution of THR (Chhatua), there appears no cause of action surviving as on date.

4. Hence, the Writ Application stands dismissed as infructuous. The Petitioner, however, may enjoy the liberty of reviving the application in case the cause of action survives in his favour.
