- 1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel for appearing for the Parties.
- 3.** The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

"It is therefore most humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to admit this writ petition, issue notice to the Opp. parties to show cause and after hearing the parties pleased to direct to the Block Development Officer, Bahanaga and Abhana Gram Panchayat to release the petitioner's honorarium as per the Govt. decision which is pending since April 2022 for the best interest of justice;

And any other order/orders, direction/directions may kindly be passed as this Hon'ble Court considers fit and proper.

And for this act of kindness, the Petitioner shall as in duty bound ever pray".

- 4.** In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting his grievance, Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.2 vide Annexure-7 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.
- 5.** As agreed by learned counsel for the parties and after going through the records, this Court, without expressing any



opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.2 to consider the representation filed by the Petitioner vide Annexure-7 within a period of three (3) months in accordance with law from the date of production of certified copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
