2. Perusal of the CRLMP reveals that on 23.02.2026, complaint dated 15.02.2026 has been sent to the IIC, Anandapur Police Station by speed post and thereafter on 05.03.2026, a grievance petition has been sent to the SP, Keonjhar on 05.03.2026.
3. The instructions dated 29.05.2026 of the IIC, Anandapur Police Station are extracted below;
