1. Heard Mr. A.C. Swain, learned counsel for the Petitioner.
2. It is submitted that by virtue of order dated 27.07.2021 at Annexure-5, the lease agreement of the Petitioner to run the medicine shop within the premises of the CHC, Ranpur, was renewed upto 20.07.2026.
3. It is further submitted that a fresh notice dated 17.04.2026 (Annexure-1) has been issued to the Petitioner to vacate the premises of the CHC by removing the medicine store in pursuance to the earlier order of the Government dated 25.04.2024.
4. Issue notice. Mr. G. Tripathy, learned Additional Government Advocate accepts notice for Opposite Parties 1 to 4.
5. List this matter on 6th July 2026 along with W.P.(C) No.13034 of 2026 and other similar cases, as prayed by learned counsel for the Petitioner.

6. As an interim measure, it is directed that the Petitioner may not be forced to vacate the shop house situating in the premises of CHC, Ranpur, subject to validity of his lease agreement.
